Building Access conversation: Senior Staff response to Mission and Ends

Mark stated the importance of mission “to drive everything”

Sr. staff gave perspectives on their recent Ends and mission discussions, referring to “circle chart” of overlapping Within, Among, Beyond

Banking Resolution: adding Telco Community Credit Union – approved

Welcome Project: Board had been advised that construction loan would be necessary due to the timing of construction payments compared to schedule for contributions to be received.

The Board approved this resolution:

Proposed Bridge Loan Resolution – approved.

The Board of Trustees authorizes the Executive to apply for a construction loan of up to \$450,000 to fund the Welcome Project through its construction period. Loan funds will only be accessed when needed and are expected to be fully repaid by January 31, 2016. Interest for the loan will be paid from either Welcome Project donations or unrestricted capital reserves.

Executive Report: What’s Happening?

Mark Ward – The extended pledge deadline is March 8, with hope to receive \$75 K donor gift. Current shortfall is \$54K for Welcome Project.

Monitoring reports:

Executive Limitation E: Asset Protection. The Executive and staff are scheduled to meet with upcoming Annual Budget Drive leaders about many dimensions of how we go forward with our congregational fund-raising including conversation about what information from campaign is disclosed and to whom.

Policy C Board Job Description

Proposed change to:

7. Monitor via internal mini financial reviews performed on behalf of Finance Advisory Committee while annually setting aside funds with goal of outside audit every 5 years.

Executive Limitation Policy H: Communications to Board of Trustees and Congregation

Proposed change to:

6. Make the financial books of the Congregation, together with appropriate related records, available for review by Financial Advisory Committee and Board and, when scheduled for audit within 90 days after the end of each fiscal year.

The Board approved the above wording changes to above policies.

Leadership Development Committee: nominations needed for LDC and Board

LDC budget should support a delegation to SUULE (Southern UU Leadership Experience) in August.
