Programs

The Minister of Faith Development, Lifespan Religious Education Coordinator, and other staff, along with the Religious Education Council may all participate in evaluating a proposal.

 1. Promote the class to membership via newsletters, Facebook posts, and posters
 2. Schedule the best classroom space available
 3. Offer reasonable support as agreed on by presenter/facilitator and staff
- Adult RE is not limited to a class-like format, but may use formats that appeal to a multiple intelligence approach (singing, movement, art, nature, interpersonal, ritual).
