

[Bountiful Cities](#) is an Asheville-based organization dedicated to teaching sustainable agriculture skills and resources in urban environments to promote social justice and economic viability. We envision abundance and food sovereign communities.

Working primarily in Asheville and Buncombe County since 2000 Bountiful Cities has promoted social justice and food sovereignty through hands-on educational programming, policy work, coalition building, urban agriculture installation, and community gardens.

Our programs include FEAST cooking and gardening education serving 800+ elementary students, Community Garden Network with 30+ gardens, Grass to Greens edible landscaping, and Windfall Nursery plant and seed saving program. Bountiful Cities is the fiscal agent for the Asheville Buncombe Food Policy Council and manages contracts with the city of Asheville promoting edible landscaping on public property. Our efforts over the past 20+ years have meant significantly more food growing in our community.

We welcome volunteers, and have multiple opportunities every week to participate in outdoor socially distanced garden work days. We also welcome volunteers in other realms of our work including social media outreach and technical assistance.
